

ARABIC STORY TELLING COMPETITION

World Arabic Language Day is celebrated on 18 December to honour the Arabic language, which is spoken by over 400 million people globally. The day has been celebrated since 2012 to mark the adoption of Arabic as the sixth official language of the United Nations by the UN General Assembly on 18 December, 1973.
