The **Brio English Club** is a club in which students can learn, improve and experience many new things through the English language.



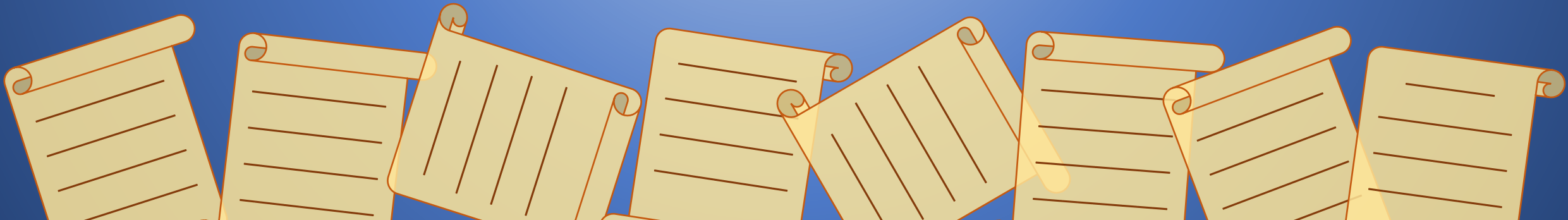
Vision

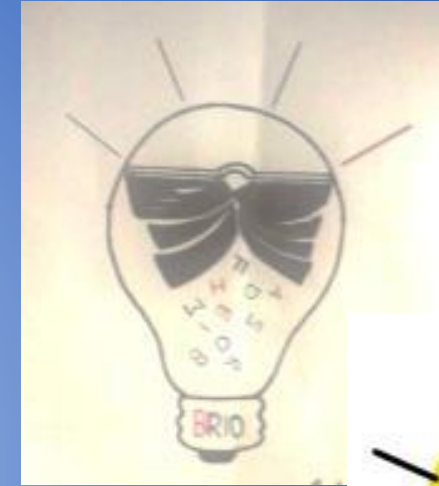
